Template-Driven Forms are more declarative and rely on Angular directives in the HTML template. They are simpler to use for basic forms, support two-way data binding, and are suitable for simple scenarios.

5. Comparison and Use Cases

Reactive Forms are preferable for complex forms with dynamic validation and reactive patterns. Template-Driven Forms are best for simple forms with less complex validation needs.

6. Developer Responsibilities

Developer will provide clear documentation, example code snippets, and guidance to Client on when and how to implement Reactive Forms and Template-Driven Forms.

7. Client Responsibilities

Client agrees to review provided materials, ask clarifying questions, and report any discrepancies or ambiguities in form implementation guidance.

Failure to enforce any provision shall not constitute a waiver of future enforcement rights.

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original but all of which constitute one and the same instrument.

18. Notices

All notices under this Agreement shall be in writing and delivered by hand, certified mail, or electronic mail to the addresses specified by the parties.

19. Headings

Headings are for convenience only and shall not affect the interpretation of this Agreement.
